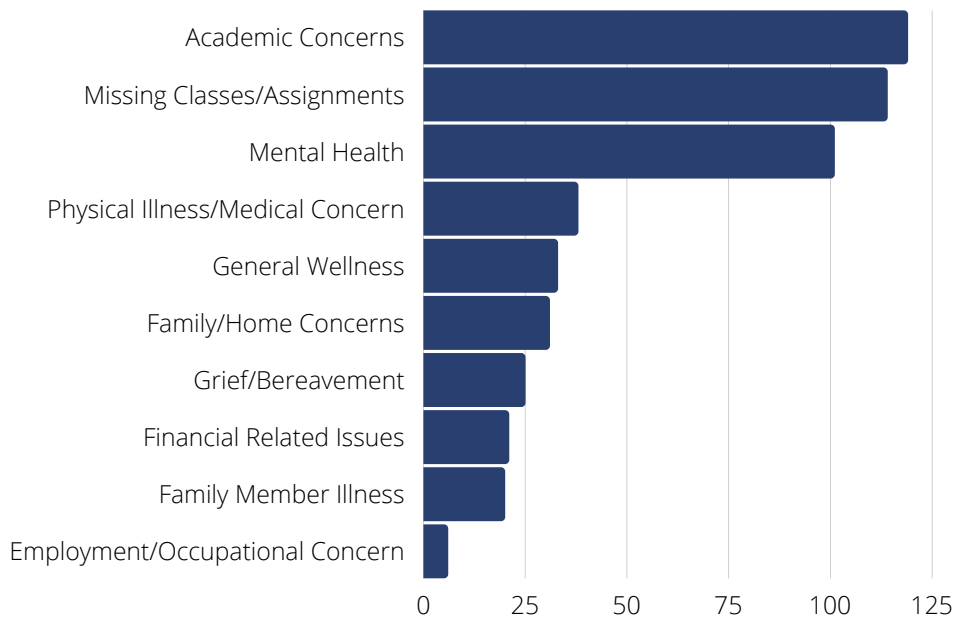

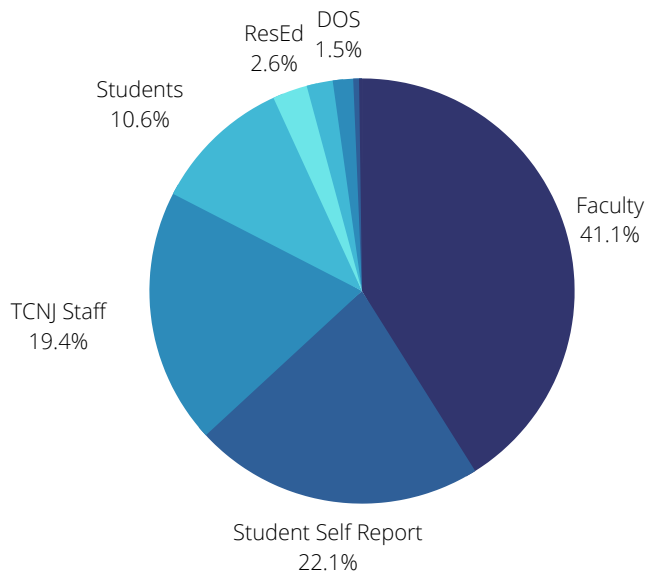
Top 10 Referred Students' Concerns



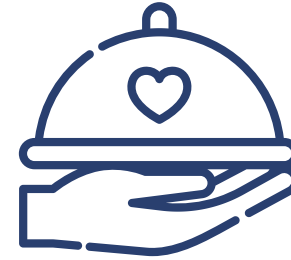
We refer students to a variety of resources, on and off-campus, during our meetings. In Fall 2020, we most frequently referred students to:

Who Referred Students?



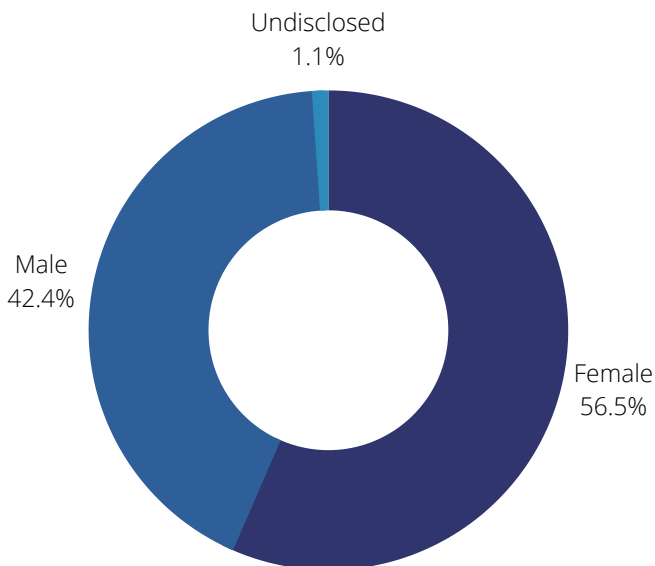
Typically, most referrals come from Residential Education & Housing as well as faculty. Due to COVID, faculty, staff and students were the source of our referrals in Fall 2020.



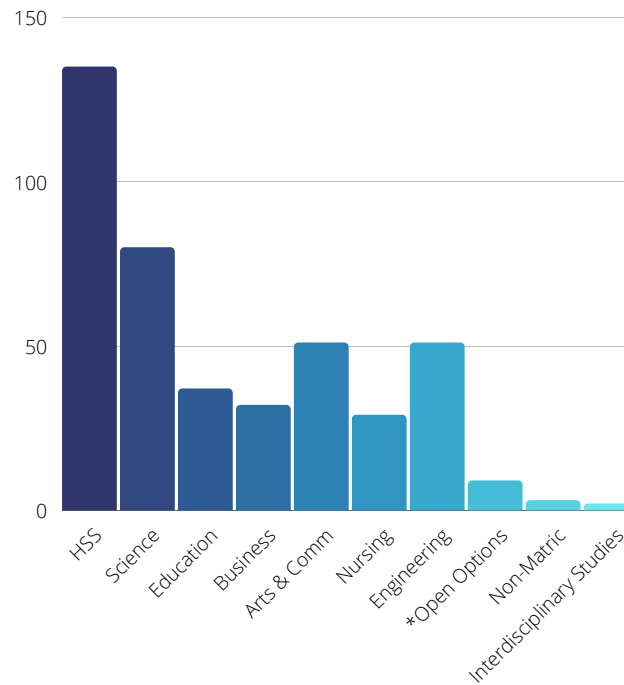
During fall 2020, we served **15** EOF students, **19** Cooperman Scholars, **33** Pride Mentoring Program participants and **15** athletes

Demographic Data of Fall 2020 CARE Students

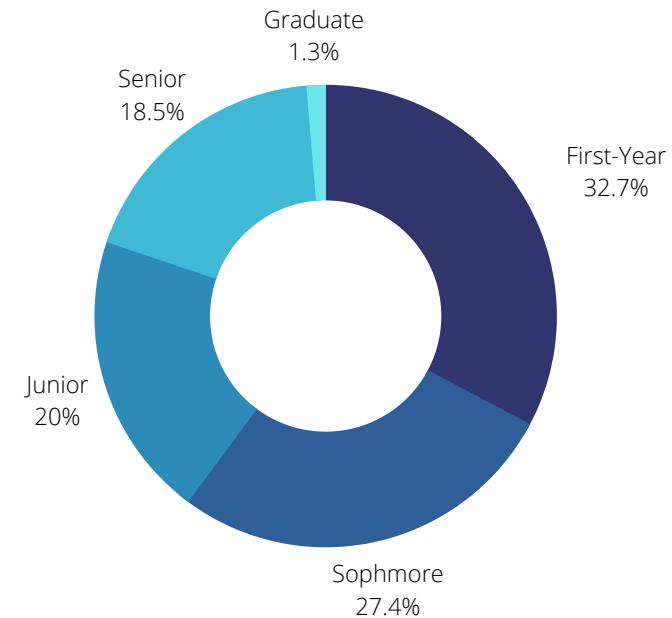
