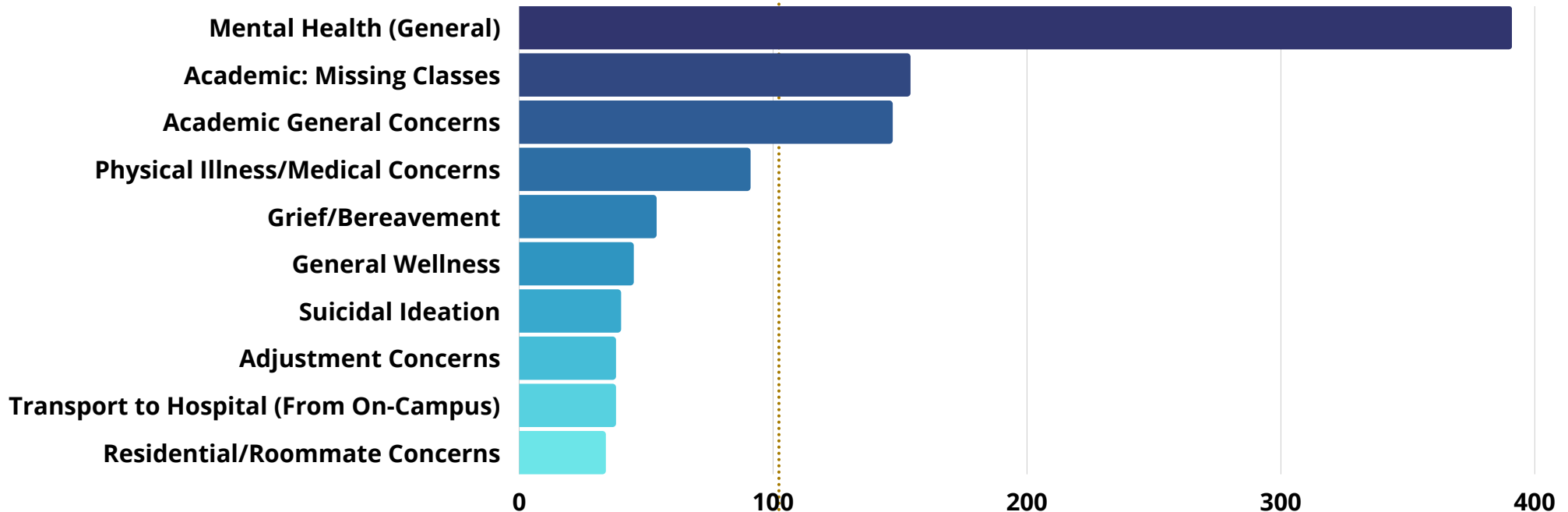

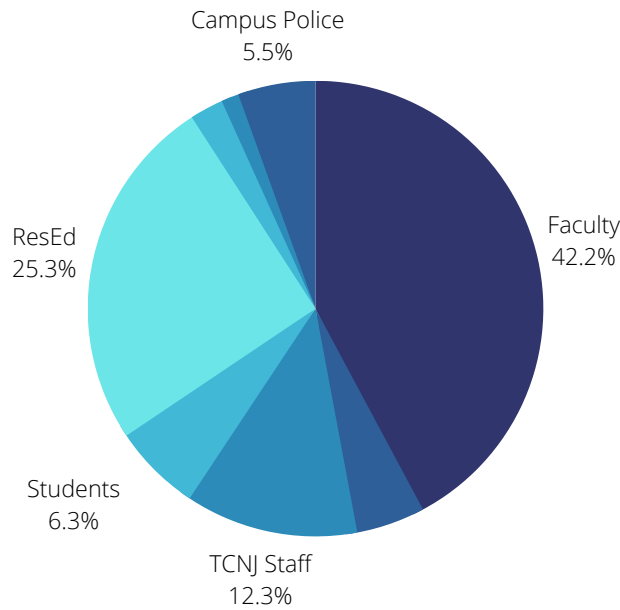

Who Referred Students?



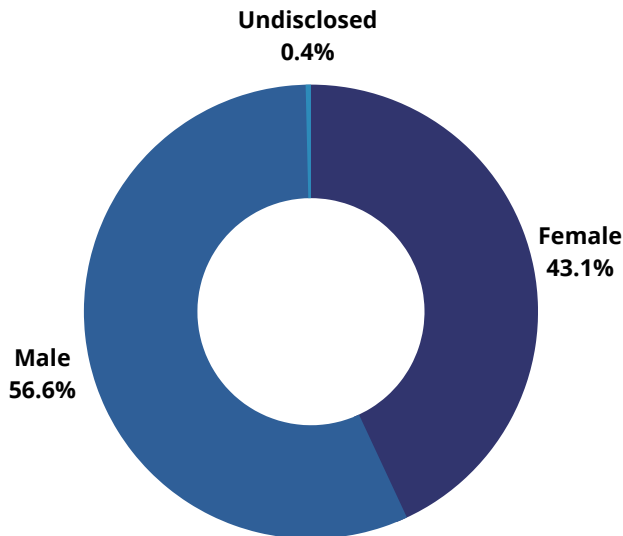
Typically, most referrals come from Faculty and Residential Education/Housing staff. Fall 2022 was no exception with almost half of our general care referrals coming from concerned faculty.



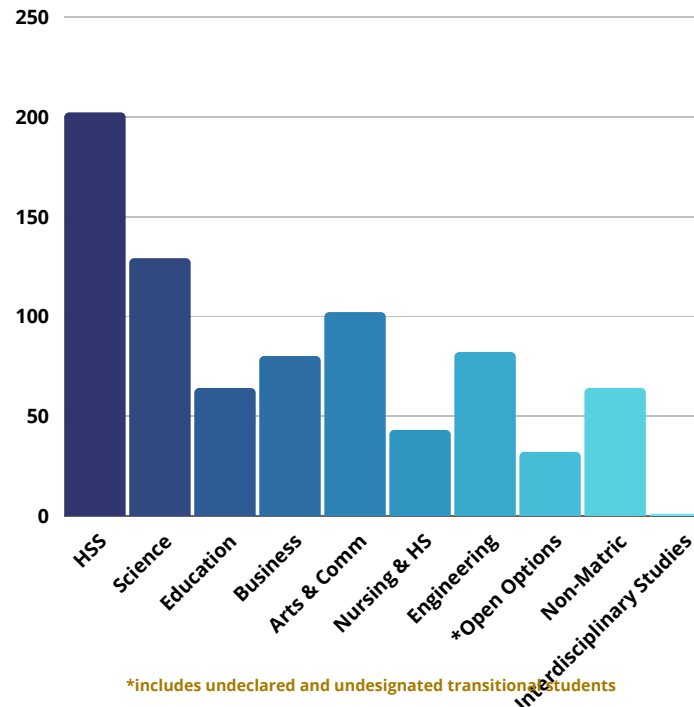
During fall 2022, we utilized 1185 meal blocks distributed from Sodexo to students experiencing food insecurity on campus (**137% increase from fall 2021**).

Demographic Data of Fall 2022 CARE Students

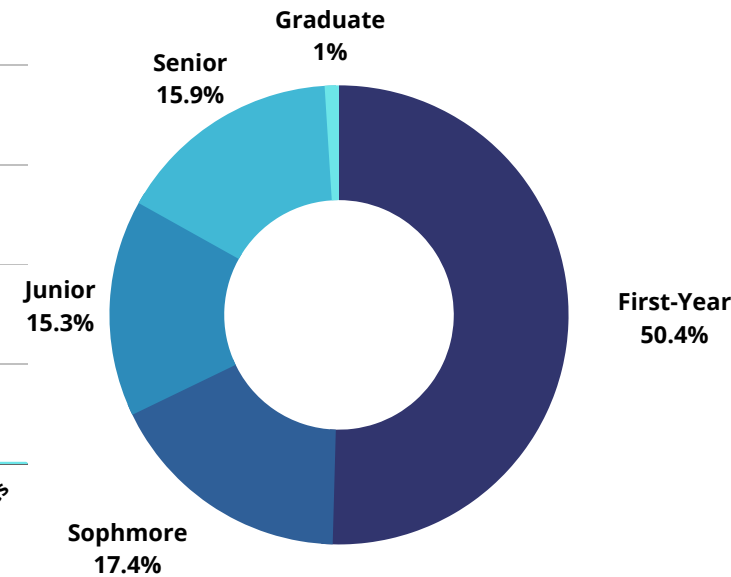
Sex



Schools

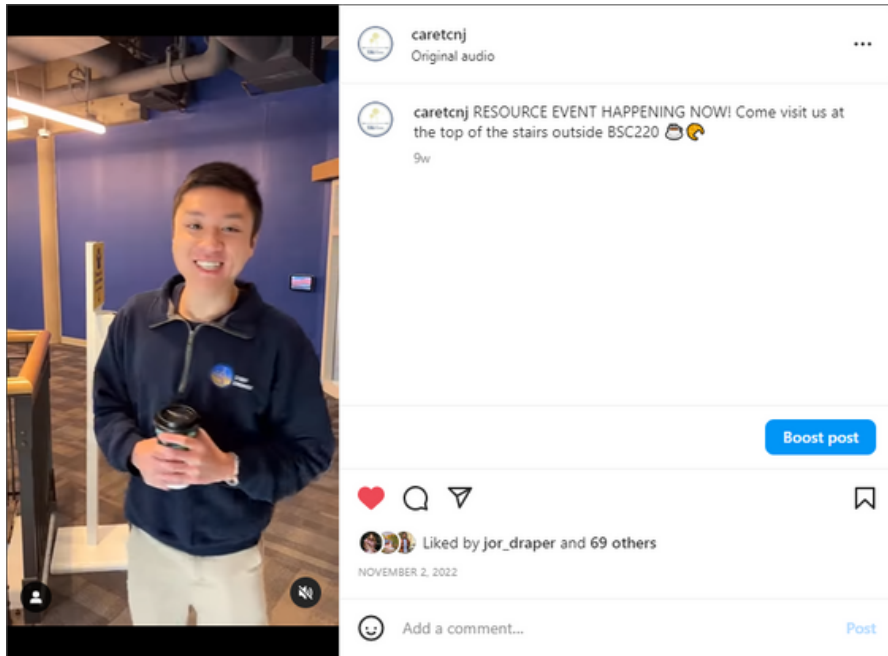


Class Year
